

AUXILIARY NURSE MIDWIFE (ANM)

COURSE DURATION :- 2 Year

ANNUAL INTAKE :- 60 students

ADMISSION CRITERIA AND CONDITION: -

1. The maximum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which Admission is sought.
2. The maximum age for admission shall be 35 years.
3. 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually for any recognized board.
4. The minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of 12 years of schooling (10+2 Year course) recognized by CBSE/BESB/ICSE a recognized equivalent examination.
5. Admission is subject to satisfactory medical examination report.
6. Admission for ANM is restricted only for female candidates.
7. **Selection Process:** Your journey towards becoming an ANM is paved with a multifaceted selection process, incorporating merit scores from 10+2 marks (if entrance exams are irrelevant), entrance exam scores (if applicable), and counseling rounds based on rank and preferences.

GENERAL NURSE AND MIDWIFERY (GNM)

COURSE DURATION :- 3 years (Including Internship)

ANNUAL INTAKE :- 100 students

ADMISSION CRITERIA:-

1. 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually for any recognized board.
2. 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually for any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government. However Science is preferable.
3. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing council.
4. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/Centre.
5. Registered ANM with pass mark.

BASIC B.Sc. NURSING

COURSE DURATION :- 4 years

ANNUAL INTAKE :- 100 students

ADMISSION CRITERIA:-

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
2. Minimum education:
10+2 class passed with Science (PCB) & English Core / English Elective with aggregate of 45% marks from recognized board under AISSCE / CBSE / ICSE / SSCE / HSCE or other equivalent Board.
3. Student shall be medically fit.
4. Students appearing in 10+2 examination in Science conducted by National Institute of Open School with 45% marks.
5. Student shall be admitted once in a year.

POST BASIC B.Sc. NURSING

COURSE DURATION:- 2 Years

ANNUAL INTAKE:- 60 Students

ADMISSION CRITERIA:-

- Passed the Higher Secondary or Senior Secondary or Intermediate or 10+2 or an equivalent examination recognized by the university for this purpose. Those who have done 10+1 in or before 1986, will be eligible for admission.
- Obtained a certificate in General Nursing and Midwifery and registered as R.N.R.M. with the State Nurses Registration Council. A male nurse, trained before the implementation of the new integrated course besides being registered as a nurse with State Nurses Registration Council, shall produce evidence of training approved by Indian Nursing Council for a similar duration in lieu of midwifery in any one of the following areas:
 - O.T. Techniques
 - Ophthalmic Nursing
 - Leprosy Nursing
 - Psychiatric Nursing
 - Neurological and Neurosurgical Nursing
 - Cancer Nursing
 - Orthopedic Nursing
 - TB Nursing
 - Community Health Nursing
- Candidates shall be medically fit.
- Students shall be admitted once in a year.

MASTERS IN NURSING

COURSE DURATION:- 2 Years

ANNUAL INTAKE:- 60 Students

ADMISSION CRITERIA:-

- The candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
- The Minimum education requirements shall be the passing of: B.Sc. Nursing/B.Sc. Hons. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
- The candidate should have undergone in B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. Hons. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
- Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
- Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.

NOTE : Simultaneous attendance in other courses is not permitted. It will be applicable to all the above courses.

- Medical Surgical Nursing
- Child Health Nursing
- Obstetric and Gynaecology Nursing
- Community Health Nursing
- Mental Health Nursing

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Any leave taken by the student without permission of the Principal will be considered as absent and will lead to disciplinary action and a fine of Ps 100/- per day or as decided by the Principal/Management.
2. Student must obey the rules and regulation of the college of nursing.
3. Students are not allowed to meet visitors during class/duty timings.
4. If any student is absent from class or clinical experience, make up of this as 1:2 days compensation. Sick leave in excess of 10 days must be compensated by the student and they have to produce medical certificate from a doctor with at least MBBS degree. All make up days will be completed every year before proceeding on vacation.
5. Vacation is granted by the Nursing college as per regulations.
6. Any student having sickness while on leave must inform the institution and bring a medical certificate from a doctor with at least a MBBS degree.
7. Each student is responsible to pay the entire academic fee within the stipulated time.
8. Visitors are not allowed during class/clinical hours except on allotted days.
9. Teaching faculties are responsible for allotting students in respective clinical areas.
10. No student is allowed to stay in the hostel during class/clinical hours without prior permission from the concerned authority.
11. They must be active, punctual, obedient and taking leadership in doing good.
12. Students should wear full uniform along with badge & ID card during class and clinical hours. Jewelry or any kind of makeup is not allowed.
13. The students are not allowed to participate in public agitation or demonstration or strike. This may lead to stern action by the school/hospital authorities which may amount to expulsion of the student/s from the training course.
14. It is compulsory that all students should purchase their own text books every year from the institute .
15. All the students are required to be punctual and are not allowed to miss classes or clinical without genuine reason and without prior permission from the class-coordinator and Principal.
16. The Student will be held responsible to cover up, if there is any damage or loss caused to the physical facilities of the school, hostel or hospital.



LIBRARY

The MGM college of nursing has a well furnished library established mainly for the nursing students. It has over 3000 books, journals (bound, Indian and foreign journal subscriptions) general reading magazines and news paper for the use of students and staff. Students can also avail the internet facilities with permission for extensive learning. The students are encouraged to make full use of the resources and abide by the rules and regulations of the library. The faculty ensures to foster reading habits among the students. The regular use of the library helps the students to widen the horizon of their knowledge and also be in touch with current information and development.

LIBRARY TIMING:

The Library currently kept open on all the working days, except the government holidays. Monday to Saturday: 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM Timings of Circulation Counter.

CIRCULATION SECTION:

Register student name, issue of books, return of books and issue of due date's particulars are being carried out in this section.

REFERENCE SECTION:

The section holds encyclopedias, dictionaries, journals, competitive examination books, and previous year's model question papers, etc. Readers need to access their resources from the reference collection. Reference books are not for lending. They can be used inside the library.

NEWSPAPER READING:

Opposite to the circulation counter is located the newspaper reading place. a notice board and a display are provided to paper cutting Xerox and all the current information will display the day to day current information in the notice board.

THESES SECTION:

Theses and mini project pertaining to M.Sc, P.B.B.Sc, B.Sc Nursing programs of our library are available for reference.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR LIBRARY

- Students should enter their names in the entry register, maintained at reference reading hall.
- Strict silence should be maintained inside the library.
- No bags, files, umbrellas can be brought in to the library.
- The library is not responsible for the patron's personal property.
- Reference materials can only viewed inside library. (not for circulation)
- Group discussions are not permitted inside the library.
- Books should not be replaced on the shelves & need to be left on the table for re-shelving.
- Walk to the library, don't run.
- Treat the books and other material with care, inside the library.
- Students can issue 2 library books on 1 library card for a week.
- Return books on time.

- Loss of library card/borrow cards should be reported to the librarian immediately.
- Issue of duplicate library card as well as borrow cards will be made against due charges.
- A fine of Rs 5/- day will be charged on late return of books issued on library card/borrow cards.
- Students can avail the facility of reference books, journals, periodicals within the library premises only against library card.
- Writing of scribbling on or tearing of pages of library books, newspapers, periodicals etc. is prohibited & will be liable for strict action.
- On loss of library book, user shall replace the same with a brand new copy or to pay the amount decided by library committee.
- Library property should not be vandalized. Difficulties if any should be discussed with the librarian.

CHILD HEALTH NURSING LAB

Our Lab is equipped with with CPR manikins, Pediatric procedure manikins with sufficient number of articles to demonstrate nursing procedures.

Students are getting hands on training on pediatric nebulization, ryle's tube insertion and removal etc.

PRE-CLINICAL SCIENCE LAB

This lab is equipped full range of miniature live models, wet specimens, loose bones, skeleton ample number of charts for easy way of learning about complicated structures of human body helps in making teaching more realistic and interesting for students.

AIMS : Pre-clinical lab aims at understanding the human anatomy, imparting microscopic view of its different parts.

PURPOSES:

- Acquaint students with anatomy of various systems.
- Provides hands-on learning experiences as directed by the nursing curriculum.
- Reinforce learning and making it an easily comprehensible one.

IMPORTANCE OF PRE-CLINICAL LAB:

Preclinical lab was created to introduce the structure and function of human body. It deals with the study of cells, tissues and membrane that make up human bodies and how that major systems function to help us stay healthy. It makes study more realistic and provide opportunity to students to develop more concrete views which promote knowledge and skills.

ACTIVITIES : Demonstration and detailed description of human anatomical structures through models, chart and specimens.



FUNDAMENTAL LAB

Fundamental of Nursing Lab is aimed at helping the students to acquire knowledge, understanding and skills in technique of nursing practice. The 1600 sqft spacious lab is well equipped with patient simulators, CPR mannequins, life form hand simulator etc. Three sides of the lab are lined with 12 hospital beds holding “patients” (mannequins) dressed in hospital gowns with a pillow, a blanket, an over bed table, a bed side table, a bed side locker, infusion stand and a bed screen for privacy. Teachers can use this area at lecture and students can practice in this area. In the center of the room is a seating area with movable tables to enhance visibility for any sized group of students.

OBJECTIVES OF FUNDAMENTAL LAB :

- It provide an appropriate environment for teaching and learning of basic nursing skills.
- To demonstrate procedures for the nursing students.
- To prepare the nursing students to practice the appropriate fundamental skills to meet the needs of patients in healthcare settings.
- To ensure the students preclinical knowledge and skills about various nursing procedures.
- To enhance students knowledge about basic nursing procedures.
- To develop an understanding and judgment in planning nursing care.
- To develop an understanding of professional responsibilities and roles in nursing care.

- Lush greenery all over the campus.




SEMINAR HALL

ANTI RAGGING

As per the guide lines issued by the UGC to prevent occurrence of ragging in the campus an Anti-ragging committee headed by the Principal and consisting of representatives of civil and police administration, local media, non-Government organizations involved in youth activities, representatives of faculty members, office superintendent, parents, students belonging to fresher category as well as senior students is functioning in this College. A smaller body anti ragging squad is functioning in the college for maintaining vigil and oversight and patrolling functions to which the incidence of ragging can be referred and which should make the on the spot enquiry and submit report to anti-ragging committee for actions.



ANTI – RAGGING COMMITTEE & ANTI – RAGGING SQUAD :

The institution keeping in mind number of students, hostel and hostel blocks shall constitute a number of Anti- Ragging Squad as it deems sufficient to implement anti ragging measures effectively.

Anti-Ragging Squad shall comprise of senior faculty members and responsible representatives of senior and fresher students.

List of Anti – Ragging Committee & Anti – Ragging Squad members is always available at Notice board of the institute for easy access to the students.

OBJECTIVES OF ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

- Anti-Ragging Committee will be the Supervisory and Advisory Committee in preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college Campus.
- The Anti-Ragging Squad- office bearers will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Hostels, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation.
- Anti-Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plan for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the college by adopting array of activities.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

- To keep a vigil and stop the incidences of Ragging, if any, happening / reported in the places of student aggregation including, classrooms, canteen, grounds, lawns etc.
- Mandated Orientation Programme for freshers and parents to familiarize them with the institutional rules and regulations inclusive of anti-ragging measures, what constitutes ragging and the consequences to be faced.

- Prepare freshers not to oblige to such practices if at all they face any but to report boldly.
- As a preventive measure a member of the committee is appointed during the admission procedure throughout.
- Regular policing by the committee members, and student's volunteer members in the beginning of the odd semester every year.
- To educate the students by adopting various means about the menace of ragging and related punishments there too.
- Assurance to maintain their confidentiality if reported.
- Make discrete random surveys.

INITIATIVES TO PREVENT THE MENACE OF RAGGING

- Put up posters on Anti ragging on notice boards and at various vantage points in the college campus.
- Anti-Ragging complaint box will be installed at various places in the college so that students can freely and fearlessly contact the committee.
- Various competitions like essay writing, slogan writing, extempore and poster making on themes/topics related to ragging and anti-ragging will be organized to create awareness among students and sensitize the young minds on various aspects of ragging.
- Anti-ragging campaign/rallies will be organized within and outside the college campus to generate awareness. Enthusiastic students usually participate in these campaign rallies with charts, posters and boards with anti-ragging slogans written on them.

FUTURE PLANS

- Arrange for professional counselling sessions to prevent any untoward incidents to both seniors and freshers.
- Appoint mentoring cells involving senior students of college

PUNISHMENT FOR PARTICIPATION IN/OR ABETMENT OF RAGGING

- Cancellation of admission
- Suspension from attending classes
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 week or equivalent period.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- Fine up to Rs. 25,000/-
